During the years 1958 to 1989, the Swedish public broadcaster SVT's reporting from Israel and Palestine was unique.

Their reporters were constantly present in the war-affected region, documenting everything from everyday life to international crises.

This extensive treasure of footage makes up the material for GIran Hugo Olsson's new film, where footage of the rise of the Israeli state is interwoven with the Palestinian struggle for independence. News coverage with Yasser Arafat and interviews with Israeli foreign minister Abba Eban during a visit to Sweden are parts of exclusive archive material that has not been shown since first broadcast.


Narrated by Tilda Swinton, **A SUDDEN GLIMPSE OF DEEPER THINGS** is a true cinematic experience.

Wilhelmina Barns-Graham was a painter, a visionary, an artist. She was a unique thinker.

One day in May 1949, Barns-Graham, then 36 years old and an emerging figure in the modernist St. Ives group of artists, climbed the Grindelwald glacier in Switzerland. She experienced an aesthetic and spiritual epiphany which rewired her brain and transformed her art. She spent the rest of her life painting it.

Through a cinematic immersion into her art and life, the film explores themes of gender, neurodiversity, climate change, and the nature of creativity from youth to old age.

When online buying highjacks our lives, how do we fight back?

Alexa, an architect and a mother, is still seeking justice against her ex-fiancé, a Belgian citizen, after years of online attacks and privacy violations. For years, her file was stuck with the local Police and nothinghappened despite the proofs she provided.

After years of absence from social media – for fear of repercussion – she opened an Instagram account to promote her work and Cedric's threatening message came the same day, reminding her that she can't hide.

Stefania, an on-line marketing professional, is seeking justice at the European Human Rights Court, suing a perpetrator for privacy violation, harassment and identity theft. Because of the police inaction, her claims were either prescribed or dismissed by the Romanian Prosecutor with the argument that what happened

GHOSTS OF THE SEA

When her brother's sailboat mysteriously vanishes, filmmaker Virginia Tangvald investigates her family's troubled past, shaped by the legend of her father, a Norwegian-born adventurer whose life was marked by freedom & tragedy.

Virginia only knew her father, the relentless adventurer Peter Tangvald, through his best-selling memoirs. After experiencing success followed by bankruptcy in Beverly Hills in the 1950's, he left everything behind to spend the rest of his life sailing the world on a boat he built himself.

Married seven times, he lost two wives at sea before dying himself alongside his 8-year-old daughter when his boat sank in the West Indies in 1991. His son, Thomas, the only survivor of this tragedy, subsequently vanished at sea without a trace, in 2014.

In an investigation taking her from Scandinavia to France via Canada and the Caribbean, Virginia sets out to uncover the secrets of her family and understand her brother's mysterious disappearance. As disturbing revelations and suspicious deaths pile up, she starts to discover what her brother Thomas may have been running from, and realizes that her father may not be the hero she — like many others — had idealized her whole life.

Flemmish DJ and filmmaker Pascal Garnier follows hiphop superstars.


Icons who also are husbands, fathers and focus on legacy.

An exploration of Gitta Sereny's work, an Austrian-British journalist and sociologist who tirelessly exposed the dark side of human nature.

Gitta Sereny spent her adult life trying to explain evil (1921-2012).

It became her obsession, positioning her as one of the first profilers of evil minds in the world. She was firmly convinced that humans aren't born evil but turned eventually due to a political context or a family background.

After The Evil takes us into the "gray areas" and traumas that we carry with us today as a heavy legacy of previous generations.

We follow Gitta's intense research process resulting in biographies of Franz Stangl, commander of the Treblinka death camp, of Hitler's architect and close companion Albert Speer, and of Mary Bell, a child murderer.

THE EICHMANN TRIAL

In 1961, History was on trial. On a trial that made history.

Just 15 years after the end of World War II, the Holocaust was already considered ancient history.

Barely taught in high school or college courses, the attempted extermination of Jewish people had been largely forgotten outside Israel.

That all changed on May 11, 1960 when Adolf Eichmann, a former Nazi officer hiding in Argentina was captured and whisked to Jerusalem to stand trial.

Over the course of a nearly four-month proceeding, filmed in its entirety and broadcast worldwide on television, many learned for the first time about the extent and horror of Nazi atrocities. During Eichmann's fiery cross-examination, a debate over disobedience to orders and the banality of evil began which continues to this day.

Told entirely through rare and never-before-seen archival footage of the trial itself and contemporaneous news coverage, The Eichmann Trial documents one of the most shocking trials in history and the birth of Holocaust awareness and education.

Sereny, and the film, both raise this question: are we all able, one day, to switch to the other side?
